Willowbrook Hospice Lottery started in 1995, before the hospice was built, and cost £1 per week to play and has remained at £1 ever since.

WHAT HAPPENS WHEN YOU JOIN?

On joining, you will be allocated a six digit lottery number, which remains yours for as long as you wish to keep playing.

THE DRAW

Every Thursday the lucky winners are selected at random. Winners must match the whole six digit number to the winning numbers drawn.

WHAT CAN YOU WIN?

The first prize is £1000 and we have a second prize of £200 per week which, if not won, can roll over each week up to a total of £10,000. The next three winners gets prizes of £125, £75 and £50 respectively plus there are 30 prizes of £10 and 50 prizes of £5.
