Annual Accounts

I have now completed the annual accounts and annual return year ended March 2017. As a result of all activities the Town Council has ended the year with an increase on its general reserves of circa £20,000 some £8000 more than targeted. This primarily due to savings achieved against budget and additional income not expected at the time of the budget setting process. Although this is very positive news, the council's reserves are still well below amounts recommended by external audit, although we are continuing to move in the right direction.

Internal Audit

The Internal Auditors from KMBC have conducted their sample testing throughout this week and have concluded there works on by signing section of the Town Council's Annual Return. A copy of the audit report will be presented to full council in May.

CCTV at Eaton Street Park

The Town Council have agreed to joint fund the installation of CCTV at Prescot Cables and Eaton Street Park. The new CCTV system will cover both playgrounds and the Pavilion building and will held in joint ownership.
