The Curators have also created bespoke beermats with fun facts for pubs and eateries in the town. This gained a lot of support from local businesses and led to two of the group's Town Criers, Mariangela and Diane, to be interviewed live on BBC Radio Lancashire about the project!

Building on their success, the Community Curators have been awarded National Lottery Heritage Funding to create a trail of artworks and experiences to share Prescot's unique heritage. The local community will be invited to take part in the creation of some of the artworks which, once complete, will be spread throughout The Shakespeare North Playhouse building for everyone to enjoy.
