Whilst the Town Council whole heartedly supports the wider regeneration efforts that have gone into Prescott Town Centre it cannot support this application for a number of reasons

It fails to provide adequate parking/loading/turning.

There are particular concerns with regard to the size of the dwellings in that they are extremely small individually, the density of accommodation is inappropriate and not in keeping with other such new developments.

There are also concerns over resultant noise from such a densely populated building and the likely highway safety issues as a result of a complete lack of parking.
